

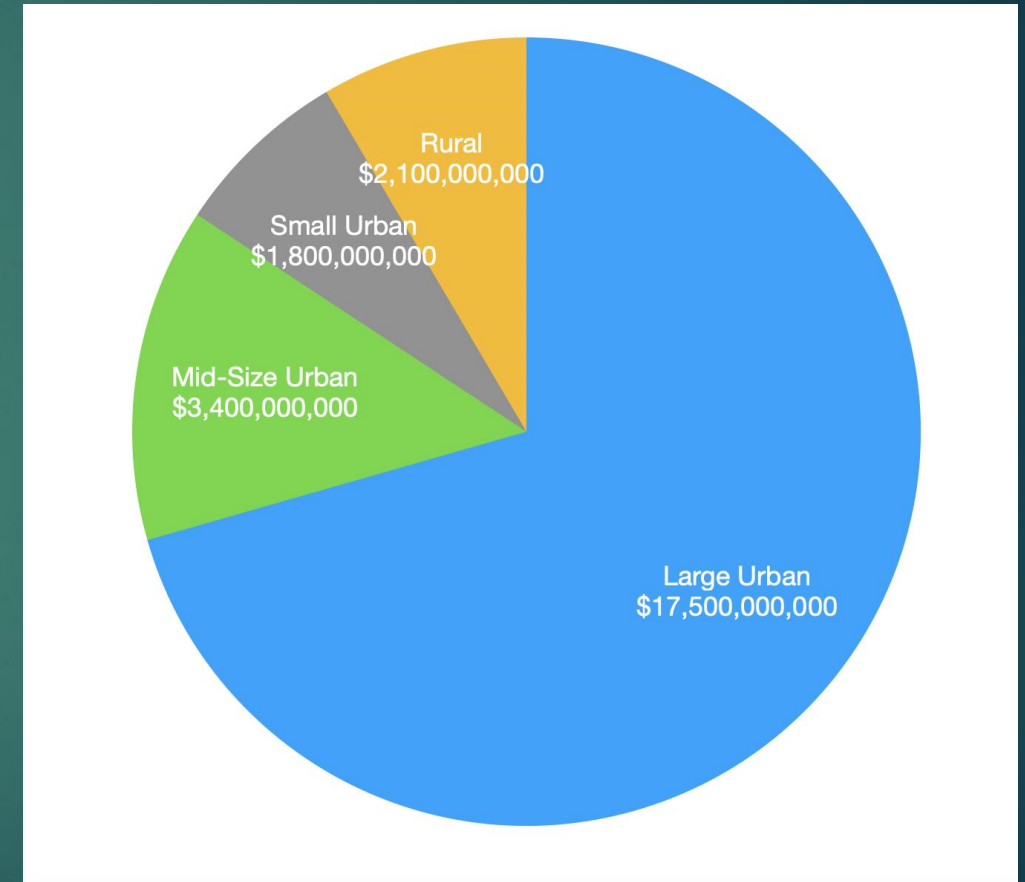

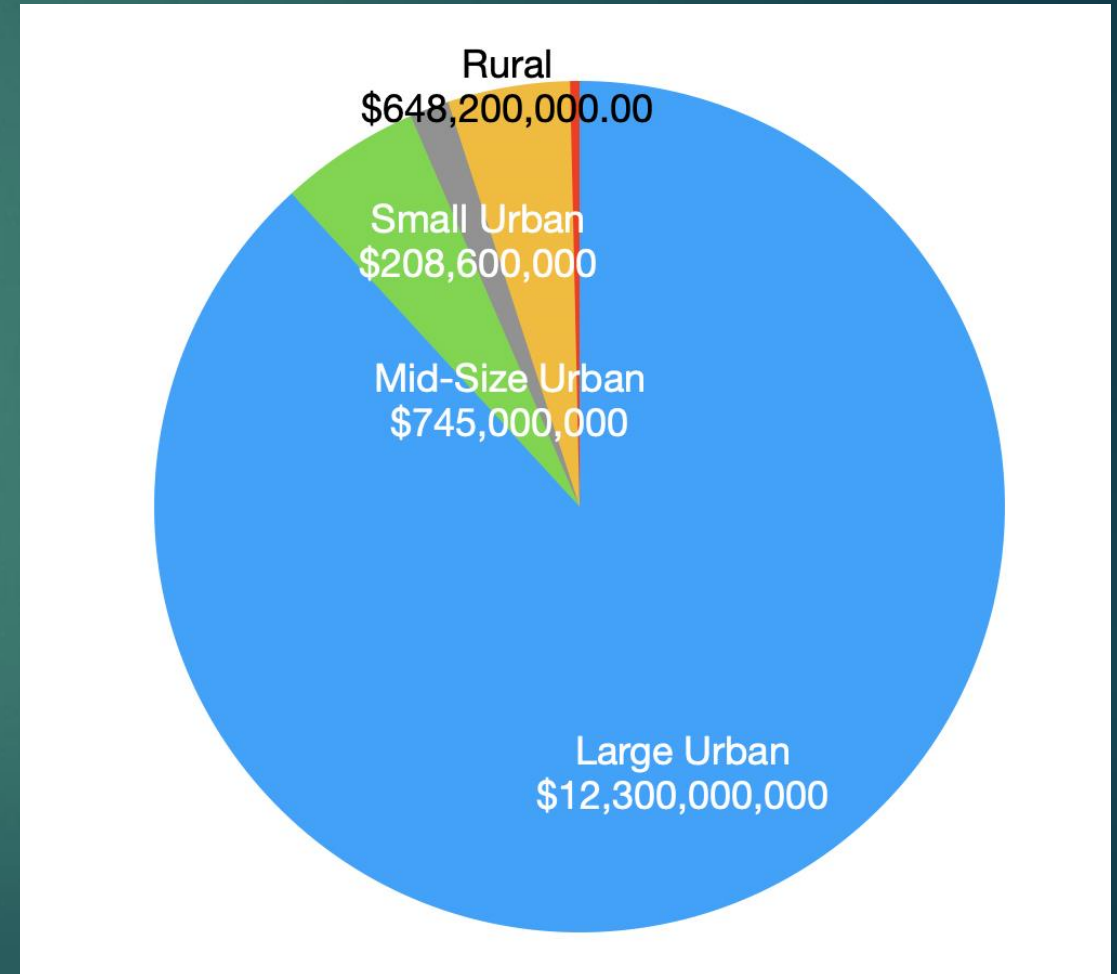
CARES Act

- ▶ Signed into law, March 27, 2020
- ▶ Mostly used standard formulas
- ▶ 100% Federal
- ▶ Unlimited Time Frame
- ▶ 71% Large Urban
- ▶ 14% Mid-Size Urban
- ▶ 7% Small Urban
- ▶ 8% Rural (all 50 states funded)
- ▶ Nothing for 5310



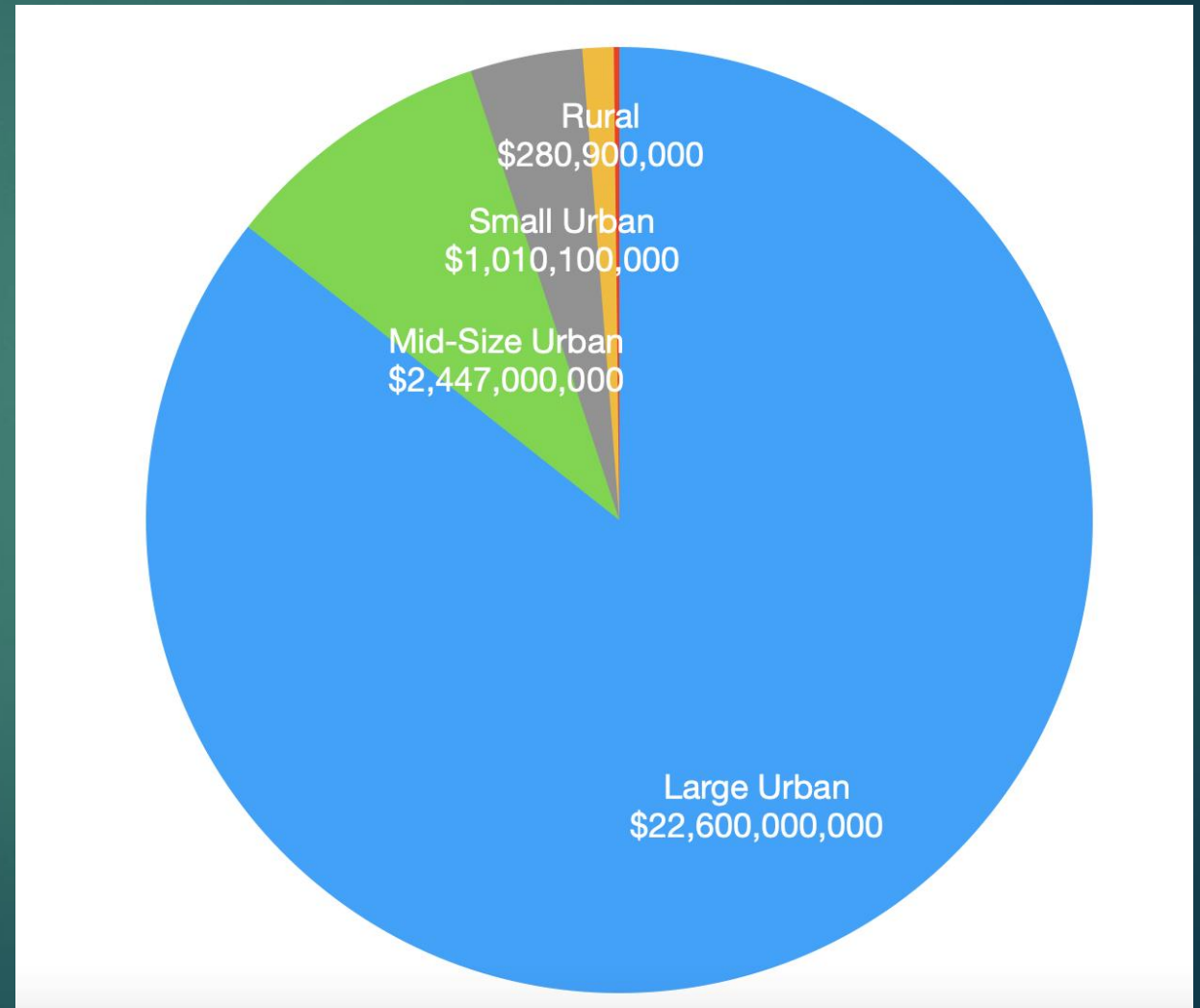
CRRSAA

- ▶ Signed into law, December 27, 2020
- ▶ Formulas based on 2018 operating expenses with caps
- ▶ 100% Federal
- ▶ No time limits
- ▶ 88% Large Urban
- ▶ 5% Mid Size Urban
- ▶ 1% Small Urban
- ▶ 5% Rural (28 states not funded at all)
- ▶ 0.3% 5310

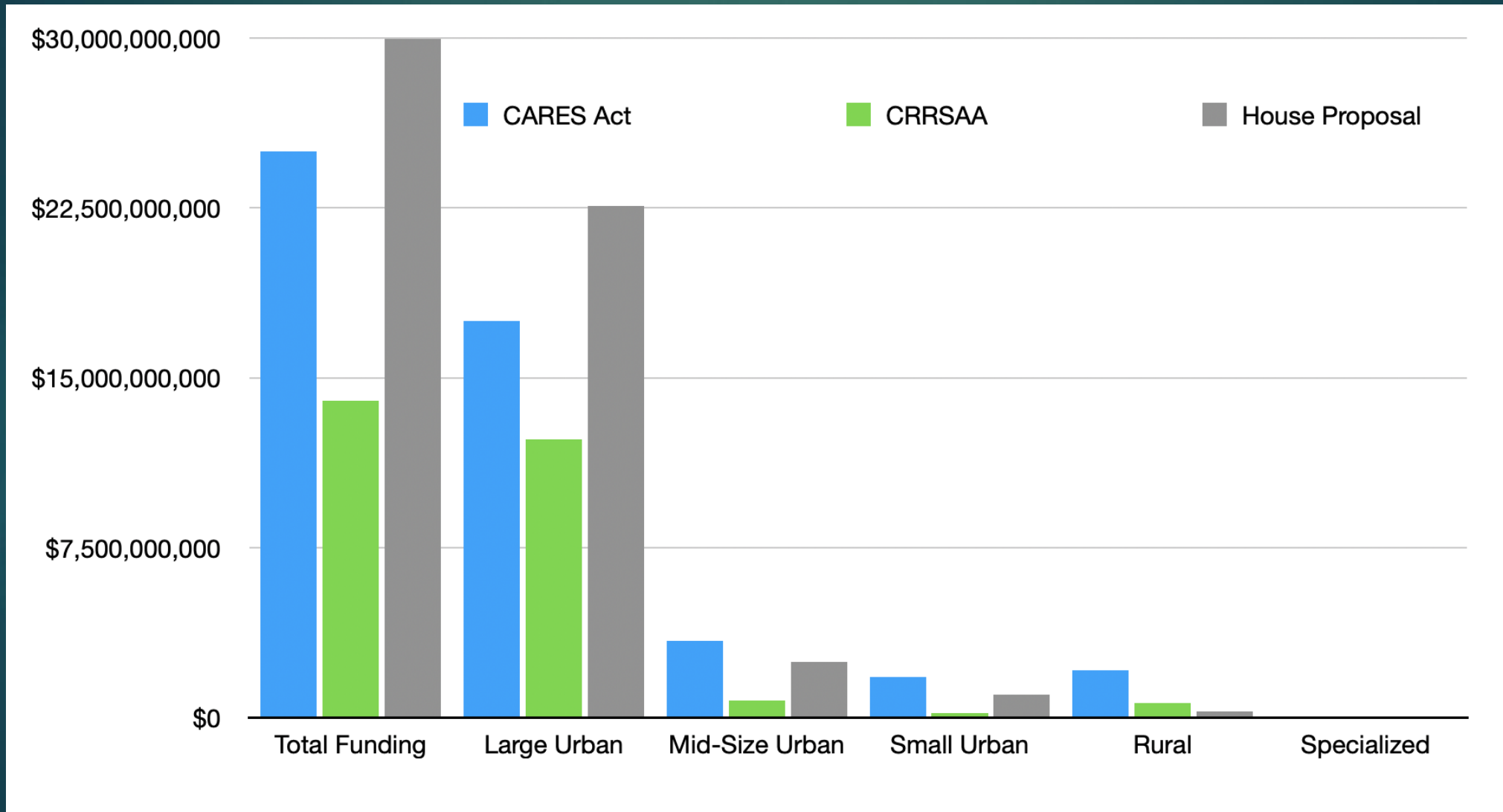


American Rescue Plan

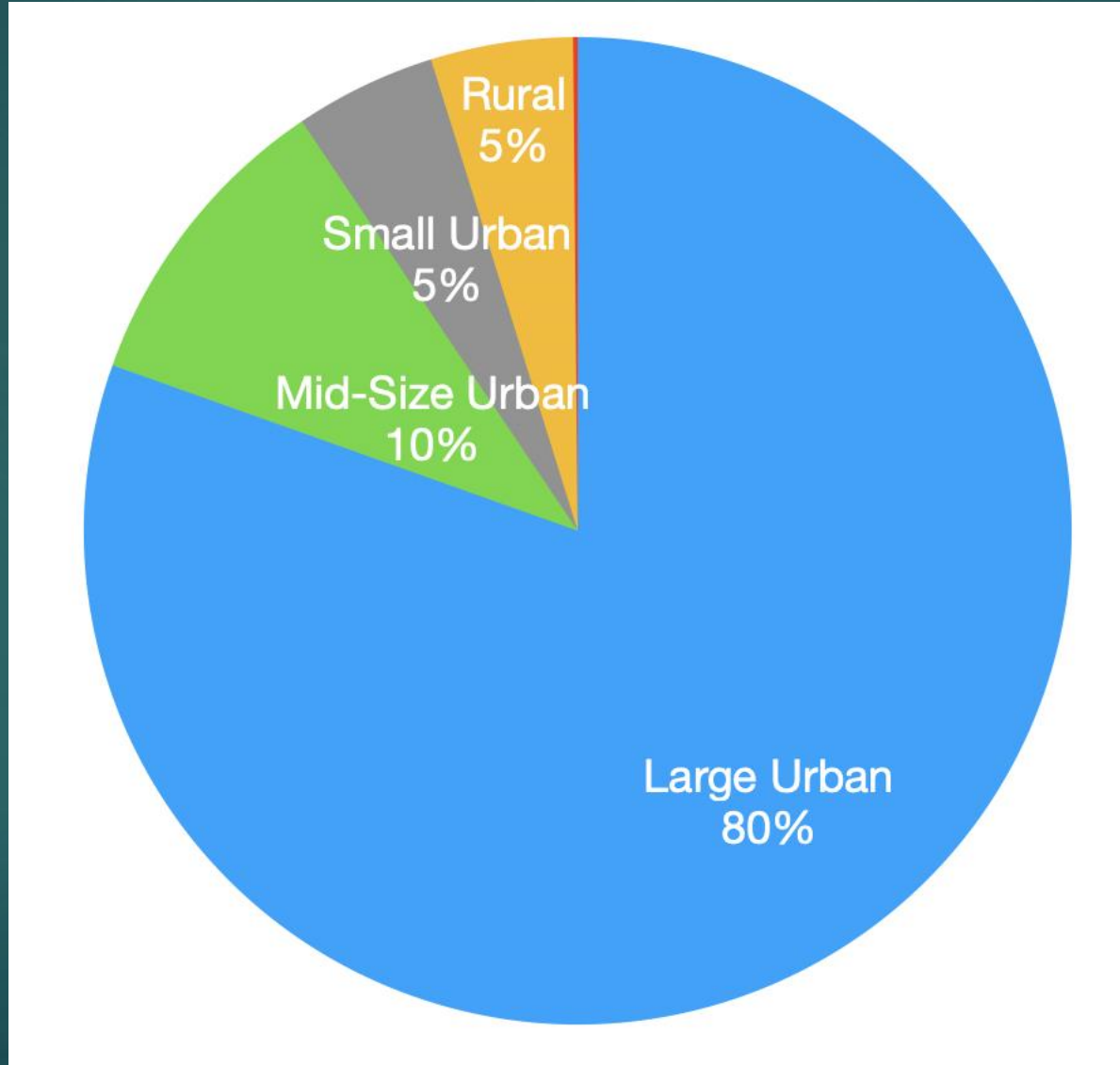
- ▶ Passed into law March 11, 2021
- ▶ Formulas based on 2018 Operating Caps
- ▶ 100% Federal
- ▶ 3-Year Time Frame
- ▶ 86% Large Urban
- ▶ 9% Mid Size Urban
- ▶ 4% Small Urban
- ▶ 1% Rural (all 50 states funded)
- ▶ 0.16% 5310



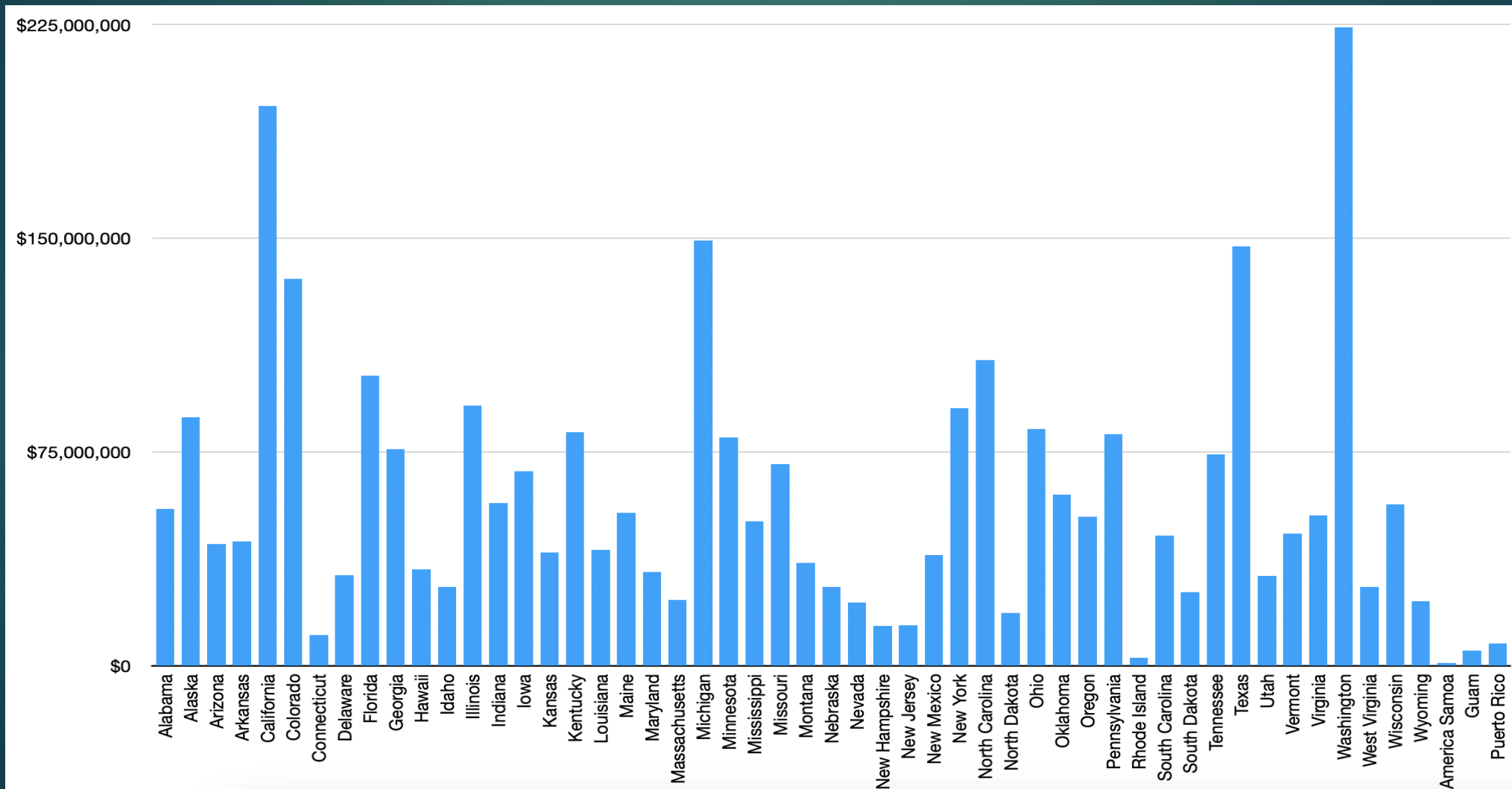
Overall COVID-19 Stimulus
