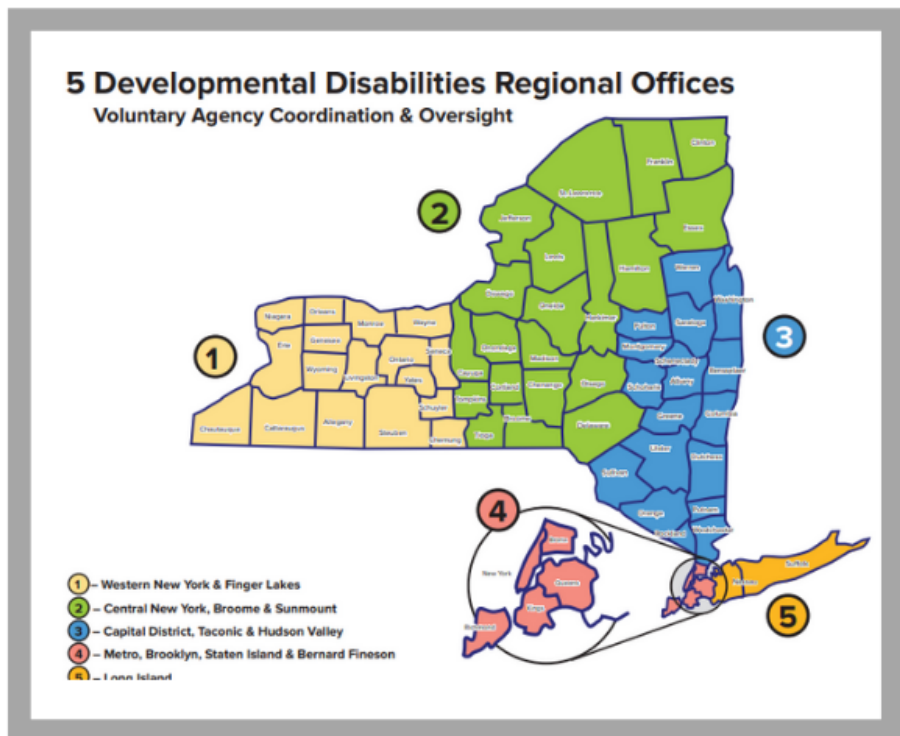
Travel Training Upstate New York

Person Centered Approach

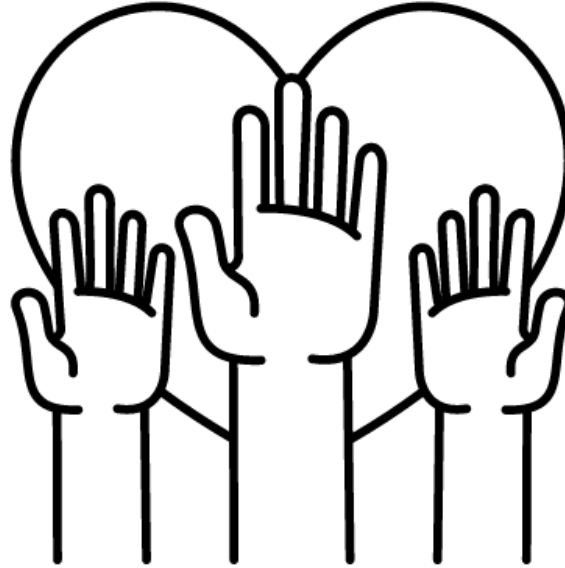

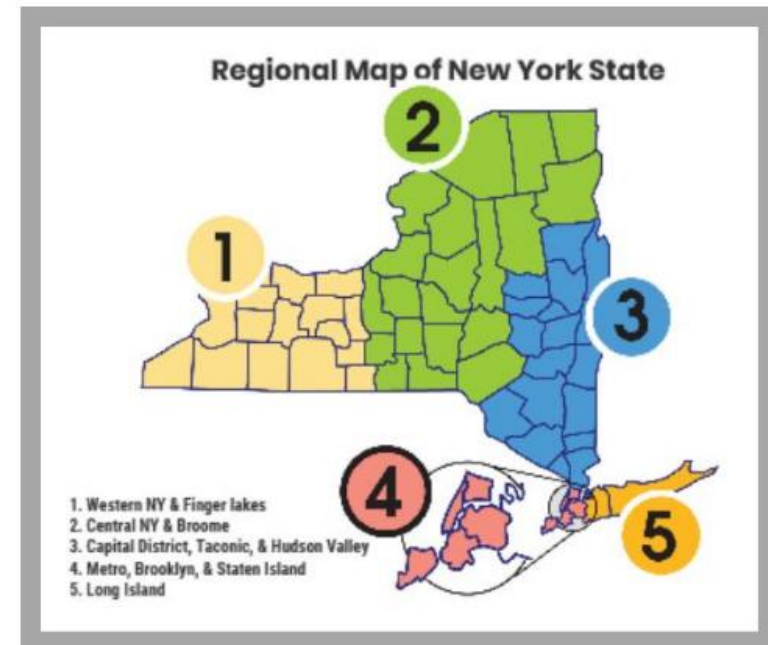

Travel Training Advisory Committee





- 18-member advisory committee
- Direct service providers, CTAA, NCMM, Cornell University, parents of individuals with IDD, & a language specialist



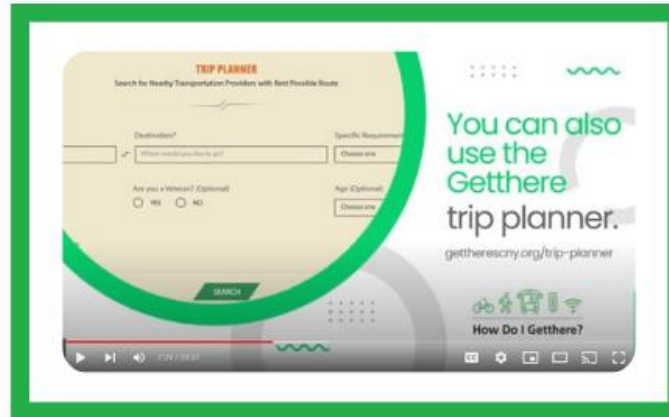


Curriculum & Assessment: Guidebook

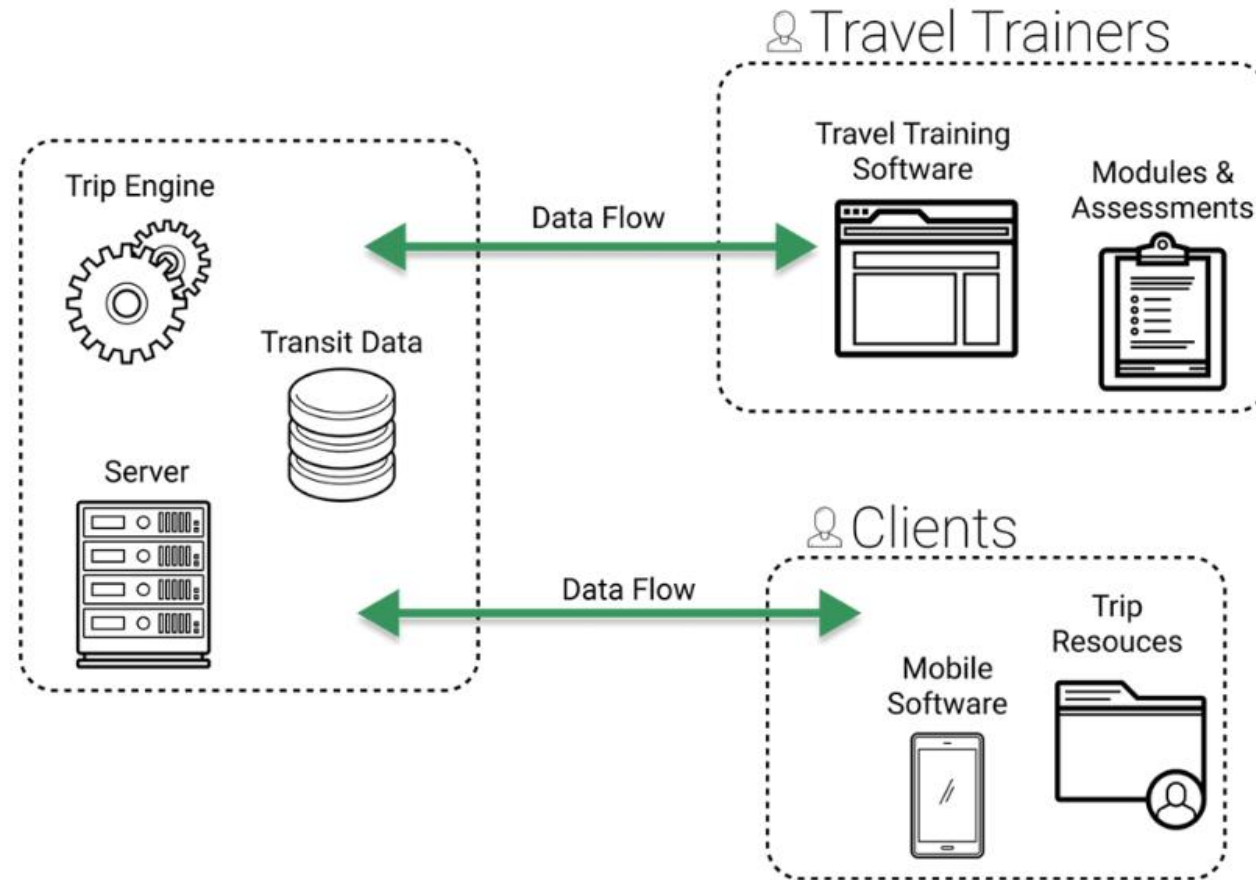

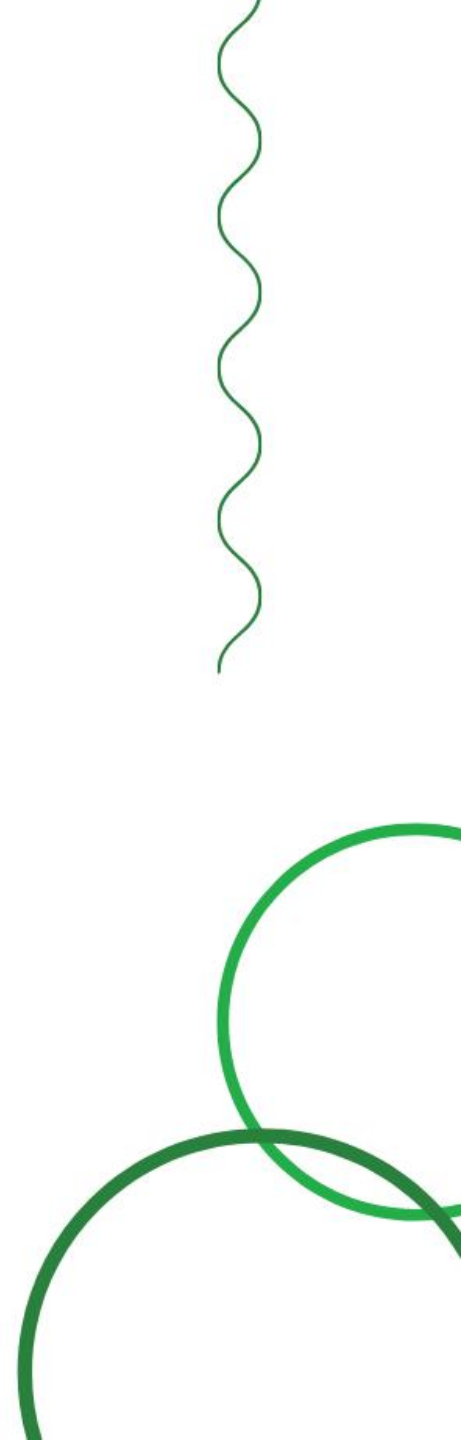

Overview

Preparing the trainee for success is a reoccurring theme throughout this guide. Safety is the key to traveling independently. Teaching the trainee to be prepared with a backup plan and emergency contact information increases their confidence and the opportunity for success.

Time: 1 hour

Instructional Aids/Materials:

- Training Scenarios Worksheet
- *How Do I Getthere?* training videos

Learning Objective: Trainee will understand and demonstrate basic transportation safety.

Task Analysis:

- Knows who to ask for help if lost
- Demonstrate appropriate/safe behaviors while traveling
- Knows who to call in case of an emergency
- Understands the concept of strangers

Important Vocabulary:

1. Emergency contact
2. Strangers
3. Personal boundaries

Adaptations:

- Adjustments for learning levels/abilities
 - Consider any social interaction challenges a trainee may have. Provide them with tools that make it easier to ask for help if needed.
